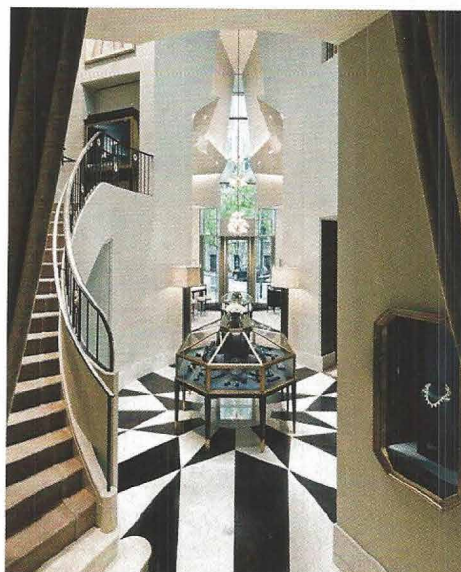
> HARRY WINSTON PAVILION, SHANGHAI
